***The Ones Who Walk Away from Omelas* Response**

Ursula Le Guin's short story, *The Ones Who Walk Away from Omelas*, provides a chilling allegory about morality, ethics, privilege and one's responsibilities in the face of a moral dilemma. The citizens of Omelas prosper at the expense of a suffering child. They understand this, are upset by it but find a way to rationalize it and accept the child's suffering as a fact of life. However, some are unwilling to participate in the society and "walk away" in protest. Upon reading this story, you are to answer whether or not you would walk away from Omelas and explain your stance in a well-reasoned paragraph. Use the TEEC format to organize your paragraph and hand in your response in MLA format. Be sure to include support from the story and elsewhere (newspaper, journal article, book) as necessary. You will be marked as per the following marking scheme.
