

Theoretical Perspectives Poster Assignment

A theoretical perspective is a point of view on a topic. It gives us a framework from which to organize, analyze, and explain observations and data. Theoretical perspectives could look at information from a macro or micro level, but are either way, based in some broader theory. In the social sciences, theoretical perspectives provide a structure for interpreting human behaviour. The theoretical perspectives studied in this course can be divided into the following categories based on discipline.

 - Systems Theory
- Psychology
 - Symbolic interactionism
 - Exchange theory
- Interdisciplinary approaches
 - Conflict Theory
 - Life Course Approach
 - Feminist Theory
 - Ecological Perspective

Your assignment is to create a poster that demonstrates one of the above theoretical perspectives. Your poster must convey the necessary information in an accurate and creative manner.

The poster may be created in any way you like; you may use MS Word or Publisher, or Glogster. You may also do it the old fashion way, with coloured pencils, markers and paper.

The poster must:

- Be on an 8.5 x 11 size paper.
- Include relevant images that enhance understanding.
- Include relevant text that conveys the information in an interesting, organized and eye catching way.
